EPISODIC BREAKDOWN

1. San Diego to Las Vegas

Join hosts Mame and Charley, as they explore great American art and architecture from San Diego to Las Vegas. Highlights include visiting the Salk Institute, and the sculpture garden Queen Califia's Magic Circle.

2. Arizona and Texas

The tour continues as hosts Mame and Charlie seek out art in Nevada, Arizona and Texas.

3. Texas to Denver

The tour continues as hosts Mame and Charlie seek out art and architecture from the Chinati Foundation in Texas, to the Clyfford Still Museum in Denver.

4. Denver to Minneapolis

The tour continues as hosts Mame and Charlie seek out art and architecture beginning with Carhenge in Nebraska, and ending at the Walker Arts Centre in Minneapolis.

5. Minneapolis to Chicago

In this leg of the tour, hosts Mame and Charlie, go to several American artistic and architectural treasures: St John's Monastery in Minneapolis, Gateway Arch in St Louis, Chicago's skyscrapers and Millennium Park.

6. Chicago to Pittsburgh

This week's riches include an extraordinary collection of modern architecture in the town of Columbus, Indiana, and a fascinating look into the archive of photographer Teenie Harris, who documented Black life in Pittsburgh from the 1930s to the 1960s.

7. Pittsburgh to Newport

On this leg, we make a side trip into Canada to look at new architecture in Toronto. We will also visit two of the great new contemporary art spaces in the United States: MassMOCA and DIA Beacon.

8. Newport to Canadian Border

The last week begins in Boston with some stunning architecture on the MIT campus and with the nearby Museum of Bad Art. For a final flourish we take a chopper across to the tiny island of Vinalhaven to meet artist Robert Indiana.

9. Best Of Architecture

Join Mame and Charlie as they look back over some of the extraordinary architectural sights of America, including: Fallingwater, The Farnsworth House, Salk, The St Louis Arch, Arcosanti, and Trinity Church, just to name a few.

10. Best Of Art Collections

Come along with Mame and Charlie as they review the top twelve collections visited this season. Choose your favourite from: Dia Beacon, The Walker Art Centre, The Chianti Foundation, The Museum of Bad Art, and The Des Moines Art Centre.

11. Best Of Americana
