EPISODIC BREAKDOWN

### 1. The Deadeye Bone Yard, Part I

A fish diver videotapes signs of a shipwreck in a 10,000 year old underwater bone yard: elephant tusks, cannons, and a wooden deadeye from a 1800s sailing vessel: all signs of a slave ship returning to Europe with a safe full of cash.

### 2. The Deadeye Bone Yard, Part II

After Tropical Storm Ernesto, Fizz and Captain Gary resume their search for wreckage of a sunken slave ship, putting together one last expedition, five dive teams and five boats to blanket search the area in search of that sunken slave ship.

### 3. Mystery of the Gold Plate

25 years ago, a diver lost his life 50 miles off the coast of Key West, bringing up a gold plate similar to one found on the Atocha (1622). In search of the gold plate site, the Treasure Divers discover a 40ft ledge.

### 4. 1733 Challenge

The famous 1733 fleet went down in a hurricane right off of the Upper Florida Keys. Carrie Cagnet challenges Fizz to find any additional treasure from 1733. He has a week to come up with some treasure or he buys her dinner!

### 5. The Missing Galleon
