EPISODIC BREAKDOWN

1. Brothers and Sisters

In this emotional episode we explore the bonds of sibling love. John reunites a young man named Ted with his brother Larry Jr, who was tragically killed in a motorcycle accident. The words of advice from the other side are truly taken to heart by a baby brother still here in the physical world.

2. A Mother's Love

Regina had been in the studio, but when there was a break in the taping, she left to attend her daughter's choral concert. So who was the first person to come through after the break? Her mother. Fortunately, Regina's sister-in-law was still in the studio and Regina was tracked down on a bus on the NJ Turnpike.

3. No Coincidences

Cameraman Evans had never worked on any John Edward show before, and he came to the job a skeptic. But when John brought through Evans's father, who had passed when he was just a boy, even Evans realized that it was no coincidence that he had been called for the job on John Edward Cross Country.

4. Living Legacies

Every once in a while, we meet someone who touches the lives of many. Fran was a chef with a big heart and a loving family. His untimely death left a void in the lives of all he knew. But rather than allow the memory of this special soul to simply fade away, his family is making sure he, and his recipes, live on forever.

5. Hearing the Message

When a loved one on the other side wants to get a message across, there is no distance too great. Bill and his daughter Tiffany came to the studio hoping to hear from Tiffany's mom. And they did. But the messages of love seemed to have more behind them, as John helped Tiffany understand. This mother continued to parent from the other side.

6. Pieces of the Puzzle

A young father comes through with a validation about his death at the hands of a SWAT team, and he takes responsibility for his passing. As John finishes up, another energy interrupts – a young girl whose unexplained death remains a mystery. She went to a party one night and never made it back home – but no one can explain how she died.

7. Always Blessings, Never Losses

Even the most unbearable of losses can be used as a healing aid for others. When son Billy comes through in the studio to his dad Bill, he has a message for his mom – but mom Cathy was not in the studio. The producers tracked her down at work, and even John was rendered speechless by this mother's powerful healing words.

8. Bonds Restored

Two sisters hear from the one person they were hoping for – their beloved grandfather. But there are bonds that are formed outside of the traditional family – a woman in the studio who provides care for an elderly friend hears from that friend's deceased husband, and he makes sure this loving caretaker's concern does not go unnoticed, even from the other side!

9. Evolving

A woman comes to the studio with her best friend and that friend's husband. She hears from two people – her young son who died tragically in a freak car accident, and her brother who took his own life. But it was what happened after these three friends left the studio that has truly forced them to learn lessons and evolve.

10. Maternal Words

John connects a grieving mother with her daughter who passed tragically in an car accident. This young woman comes through with a fun validation for her mom – that she considered mom more of a friend than a parent.

11. Soul Print

When John sits with television personality Leeza Gibbons, he learns about her work helping the caregivers for Alzheimer's victims. Leeza's own mother suffers from this disease, dubbed the "thief of memories," and in this episode she shows John how she lives her life by communicating, appreciating and validating her mother, every single day.

12. Guidance from the Other Side

John gets a reference to brain surgery, and it's a son's on the other side's way of talking to his mom Marianne in the studio. Michael passed very suddenly in a freaky motorcycle accident that by all rights should not have taken his life.
