1. UFO's Over LA

February 1942, the sky over Los Angeles erupts like a volcano. AA guns around the city begin firing on strange targets. The Navy attributes the incident to "war nerves", but an explanation is not provided. Witnesses believe the raid was real, and the origins of the craft may be extra-terrestrial.

2. Red Alert

During the Cold War, with the world on the brink of nuclear holocaust, strange lights and unidentified objects that hovered over top-secret military facilities put governments around the world on red alert. Could extra-terrestrials have been observing and keeping track of the world's nuclear arsenal?

3. Black Triangle

In the 80's and 90's mass sightings of large, black, slow moving, triangular objects began to occur in the night sky. This type of UFO had never before been witnessed so frequently. Using 'declassified files' relating to Black Triangles we will investigate some of the most widely witnessed UFO events ever.

4. UFO Crash Sites

Alien autopsies, secret military files, and recovered pieces of an extraterrestrial spacecraft: the Roswell incident is re-investigated in the field and in the lab, with tests that will prove beyond any doubt whether the crashed UFO was from earth, or another planet.

5. UFO's vs Airlines

Who knows the skies better than those who work there every day? Firsthand accounts from pilots who have encountered large unknown flying 'craft' over the British Isles, Alaska, and the New Mexico desert will have you asking, "are we safe from UFOs at 30,000 feet?"
