### 1. Assassination of Malcolm X

The Lost Tapes: Malcolm X chronicles the incendiary civil rights activist's meteoric rise amid the violent unrest of the 1960s. The episode unearths rare archival footage to capture his charismatic personality, fiery rhetoric and prophetic vision that were silenced in a hail of bullets in 1965.

### 2. Tet Offensive

In January 1968 America thought it was winning the Vietnam War. With rare battlefield reports, the Tet Offensive story is told, as North Vietnam mounted a devastating nationwide surprise attack putting a dagger in U.S. hopes for a quick end to the war.

### 3. DC Sniper

For 23 days in October 2002, residents in the Washington, D.C. area are human targets as a sniper randomly opens fire on schools, gas stations and grocery stores. Ten are killed, three injured. Police will need a lucky break to stop the slaughter.

### 4. Super Tornado Outbreak

On April 3, 1974, a swarm of killer tornadoes swept through the American Midwest obliterating entire towns and devastating 900 square miles across 13 states. In just 18 hours the Tornado Super Outbreak killed 315 and became one of the worst natural disasters in U.S history.

### 5. Apollo 13

In April of 1970, a large explosion occurred on the Apollo 13 mission as the astronauts were halfway between the Earth and the moon. The spacecraft was crippled and rapidly losing power. It took the heroic efforts of the crew and Mission Control to defy the odds and return Apollo 13 to Earth safely.

### 6. Clinton Impeachment

A civil lawsuit against the president is the catalyst for a 4 year \$40 million fact gathering crusade. Eventually leading to the uncovering of a 16 month long inappropriate relationship between POTUS and a 22-year-old White House intern and ending with the impeachment of the 42nd United States President.
