### EPISODIC BREAKDOWN

#### 1. The Cuban Dream

Student Cray Novick goes to Cuba and meets artists, ethnographers and everyday Cubans who reflect on Cuban reality today. Their stories reveal the evolution of Cuban society dating back to 1960. Barack Obama becomes the first U.S. president to visit Cuba since the 1959 revolution. Cuba is changing and Cubans are searching for a collective Cuban dream.

#### 2. The Embargo

Cuban politics are complicated, but Cuba won't rest. A soccer league for social change energizes Havana. Carlos Gutierrez considers Cuba's changing economic landscape. Clandestina becomes the first Cuban brand to sell online. Bernadette Meehan, and Ben Rhodes, discuss the impact of Obama's visit on Cubans. Doris Kearns Goodwin reflects on Cuba, the embargo, and revolutions.

#### 3. Salud

Cuba's healthcare innovations manage to work so well, with such few resources. Follow a Cuban Doctor and nurse on home visits to see how Cubans access healthcare. In the lab, biomedical technology has cured diabetic foot ulcers. As global tensions rise, Cuban doctors are being sent home from their remote postings around the world. International students compare their experience attending Cuban medical school, with their home countries healthcare.

#### 4. Sueños

A Cuban taxi app launches as internet access in Cuba grows. Musical sensation Cima Funk tours internationally, defining his global identity. Cubans in Miami reconcile with a traumatic past. Rick Steves tries VR for the first time. Alan Gross reflects on his imprisonment in Cuba. Cray is no longer a student, but he's a dreamer, and the Cuban dream is still being realized.
