Bordering Myanmar, Laos and Vietnam, Yunnan's distinctive nature reserves were awarded World Heritage status for their rich biodiversity. Destination China takes you to some of China's most beautiful landscapes, home to 6,000 species of plant, 200 mammals and 500 birds. We travel from snow-covered Shangri La in the north, to the tropical Xishuangbanna in the south. White-cheeked gibbons are the most endangered animals in China. Meanwhile, China's elephants are only found in the extreme south of the Yunnan province. They number between two and three hundred and are highly endangered. This celebration of diversity, survival, and the wonders of natural beauty is a feast for the eyes.

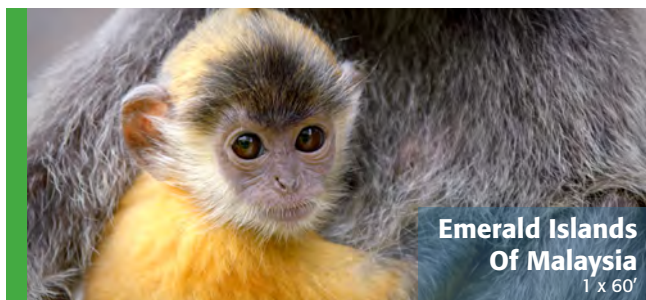


The eagle has landed...in our backyards. Nesting on hydro towers, construction beams, in suburban parks, and urban neighbourhoods, bald eagles are an exotic reminder of the wilderness that surrounded many of our cities' landscapes. These majestic predators epitomize survival. Their story is one of opportunism and adaptation in the face of a rapidly changing ecological landscape. We follow the unfolding story of a single breeding pair in the suburbs of Vancouver, Canada, over the course of a year. Via the social media phenomena known as 'nestcams' we are able to witness their amazing lifecycle, and understand the adaptations they've made to be successful in the city. Wildlife biologists, conservationists, rescuers, and online nestcam fans illuminate the lives of our newly arrived wild neighbours. It is possibly the world's single greatest conservation success story, Bald Eagles have gone from the brink of extinction to numbers never before seen in just fifty years.

### **Emerald Islands Of Malaysia**

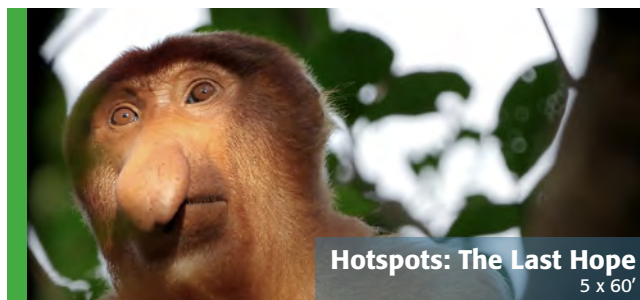

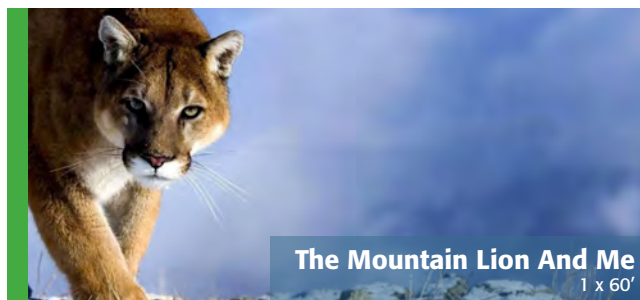

**Naledi: A Baby Elephant's Tale**

Naledi tells the incredible story of a baby elephant born into a rescue camp in the wilderness of Botswana. Born on an incredibly starry summer night in 2013, Naledi (which means 'star' in Setswana) was orphaned just six weeks later when her mother died. This meant that immediate action had to be taken to both comfort Naledi - and save her life. It took a dedicated team working around the clock to nurse her back to health. Naledi's boisterous yet loving personality ensures a deep bond with the staff at the rescue camp as well as the female elephants of the rescue camp, but this isn't just one elephant's story. Camp scientist Mike Chase has launched the most ambitious ever census of African elephants: a last ditch effort to ensure their survival. He is racing to defend an entire species while struggling to save a single life.

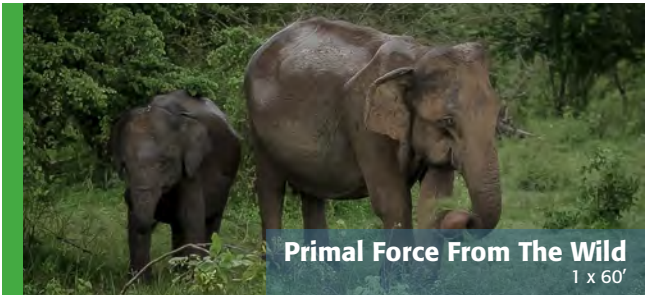
**Nigel Marven's Wild Philippines**

The Philippines has a greater variety of life per square mile than any other country. Half of its 52,000 species are found nowhere else on Earth. An archipelago of 7,000 tropical islands scattered in the Pacific, it's a land of contrasts, from calm tropical seas sheltering delicate castles of coral, to the smoke and fire of twenty active volcanoes; from the world's largest eagle to one of the smallest primates, the tiny tarsier. With exclusive access to the Philippine Eagle Centre, we stake out the nests of these highly-endangered birds and film adult eagles training their young to handle their prey. A sequel to the hugely successful 'Wild Colombia with Nigel Marven', this series will be one of the first to reveal the extraordinary natural riches of the Philippines. Many of the country's creatures have never been caught on camera before.

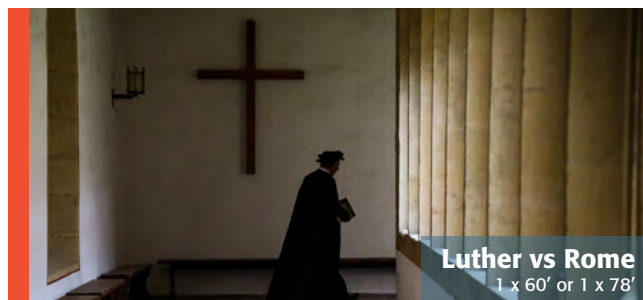


### The Lost Tapes

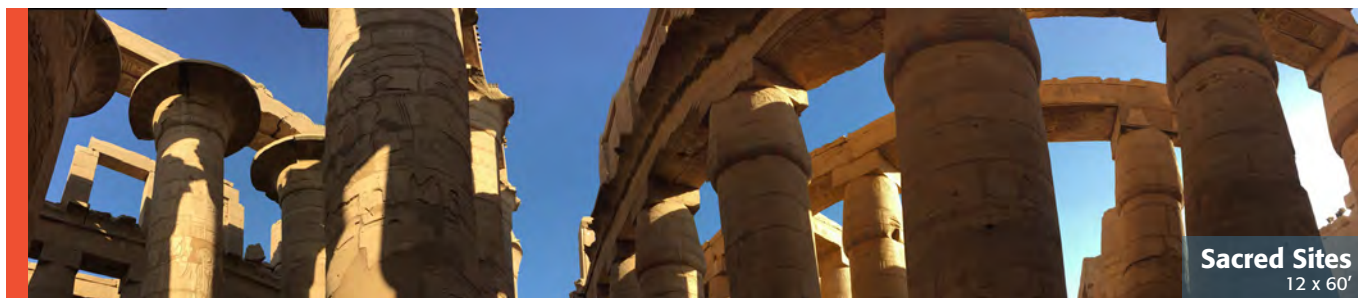

## Smithsonian Time Capsule: 1968

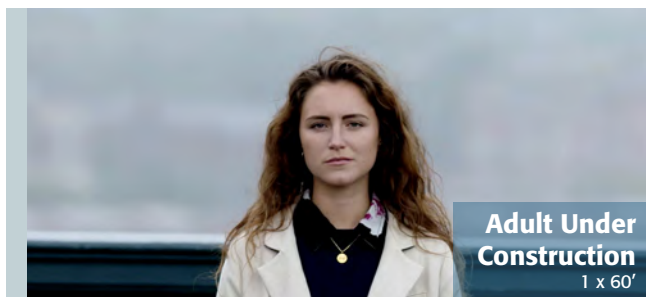

In 1968, things just wouldn’t stop happening, each passing week brought a new bombshell headline. Politically, the Revolution of ‘68 challenged old conservative regimes across Europe and Latin America. At home, opposition to the Vietnam War and engagement in the struggle for civil rights overcame non-violent philosophy to create a volatile mix of activism and rioting, greatly accelerated by the assassinations of Martin Luther King Jr. and Robert F Kennedy. Then a backlash makes ‘law and order’ candidacies successful and reshapes the political parties. Optimism turns to disappointment, but progress continues – from the first African American woman elected to Congress to the birth of the women’s movement to big wins in space with the Apollo missions. And throughout it all, Smithsonian Curators were collecting objects to help tell the stories for future generations.
