Mountain Lions are one of the most elusive creatures on the planet, some say harder to film than snow leopards. Most people live their lives without even a glimpse, while those who have seen a mountain lion describe the experience as fleeting, more a shadow than reality. That is until one fateful winter's night when a wild female mountain lion revealed herself to Casey Anderson in Montana, he began filming an intimate view of her life and newly born cubs.


The Guy With The Knife









The Nuclear Requiem
