1. Luzon: The Volcanic North

The world's 15th Biggest island but the largest in the Philippines. A land of contrasts; from the urban sprawl of the capital Manila to huge hidden forests, the world's most species-rich reefs and a dozen active volcanoes that dominate the skylines. Nigel meets the extraordinary creatures that live in these landscapes.

2. Palawan: The Last Frontier

The most westerly island in the archipelago, Palawan is known as the Last Frontier. Nigel will explore its ancient rainforests, pristine coasts, coral reefs and incredible underground treasures.

3. Visayas: Heart of the Archipelago

A scattering of islands, Mindanao (the second largest in the Philippines), Bohol and Cebu, are home to a bizarre array of creatures and stunning landscapes. Nigel introduces us to Bohol's world-famous Chocolate Hills, strange mounds of dissolved coral some 45 million years old and the iconic Mount Apo where the world's rarest eagle is making a comeback.
